Our Support Services for Veteran Families team has hit the ground running since we were awarded the \$880,000 grant in November. Since the start of the SSVF program, many veteran households have been delivered from homelessness to permanent housing.

One story sticks out in my mind: when the Smith family was referred to us they were living in a utility trailer in 20 degree weather. They had a two year old son and another little one on the way with no hope of jobs or housing options. That same day we housed them in a nearby hotel, within the week the husband was hired at a full-time job, and within the month, permanent

One of our 2014 highlights was our partnership with Mercer Creek to administer the Hope Fund to fill the gap for clients in need.



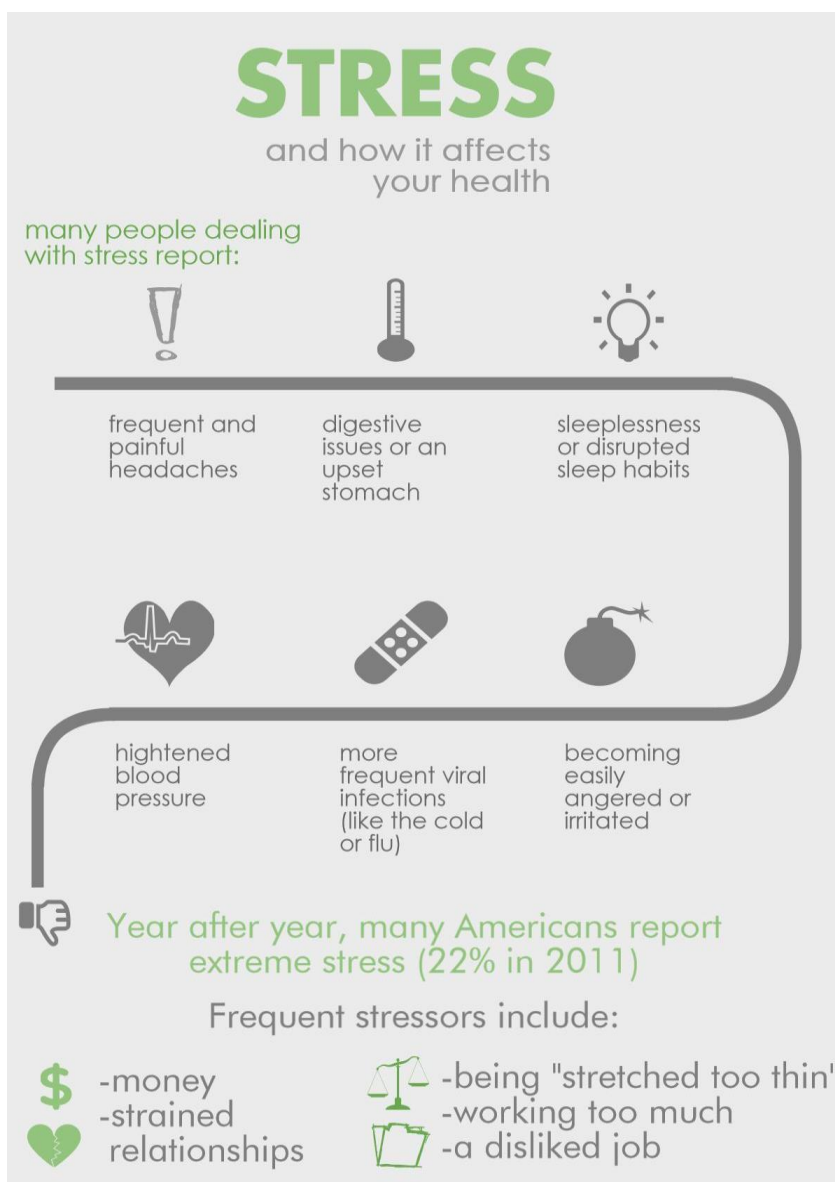
Recently we were able to assist Justin with all of her

Last month we purchased seven homes on Cora Street in Ellensburg!

Each of the homes are three bedroom, two bathroom, single family dwellings. The acquisition of this property will help us provide safe, affordable housing for families in our county. Currently all of these units are occupied with renters but over time will be available to Pathways Participants who are working towards home ownership.

While in the program, participants live on site with reduced rent so that they can save money for a down payment on a home of their own. Throughout this process they are working one on one with our financial coaches to build the skills needed in order to be successful homeowners. We are so excited about this opportunity to partner with families in realizing their dreams.
