I had the opportunity to interview some of the executive leaders of our organization recently. The premise was to learn what brought them to where they are today, and to see if I might be able to pick up on a common denominator. I learned about important leadership qualities and the value of setting high expectations for self as well as those you are called to lead, and additionally spent time pondering the dangerous counterpart; “If I don’t expect much of you, I don’t think much of you.”
