Energy Assistance Sign-Ups Open October 20th @ 8am

The HopeSource Energy Assistance Program can provide help paying for a variety of different heating costs. Eligible participants can receive benefits ranging from \$25 to \$1,000. Eligibility for the program is based on available funding and your household income. Please see the chart below for income limits based on the number of people in the household.
