Workcamps are intensive one-week trips that help people grow in Christian faith through service. Individuals and youth from around the country will spend one week in our community performing hands-on home-repair projects for elderly, low-income, and disabled families. The work at each home will be done by 5 young people, and at least one adult leader, representing many Christian denominations. Eligible repair projects may include:

- Porch repair/construction
- Step repair
- Exterior painting
- Interior painting
- Weatherization
- Wheelchair ramp repair/construction
- Mobile home skirting
- Roofing (no tear offs)

Worksite Selection Criteria-

- The resident must be elderly, low-income, and/or disabled
 1. Elderly (60+)
 2. Low Income (refer to chart below)
 3. Disabled (state recognized)
- The home should have obvious need of repair (Must mandate a 4 day repair with a work group of 6)
- The resident should own the home, If home owner is unable to be there during construction, they need to have a designated adult (approved 1 week before camp) to stand in on their behalf (June 26-29)
- The selection of work must keep a crew of 6 people busy for 2.5 days
- The worksite is within a 30-minute driving distance of the host lodging facility (Walter Middle School)
- The work environment is socially and physically safe for teens. Disqualifying circumstances can include the presence of pornography, firearms, drug or alcohol abuse, domestic violence, electrical hazards, and/or severely unsanitary conditions (If there are going to be fire arms present in any of these homes, we ask that they are removed or in a locked safe)
- Online background check will be run on all approved homes. Each individual in the home must pass a basic background check, which will include the past 10 year's history. Conviction of any items listed below may result in a denial of application.
 1. Reoccurring drug abuse
 2. Sexual abuse at any point
 3. Assault

Work Site Selection Crew Criteria-

- 1 person from Roslyn, Cle Elum, South Cle Elum and Ellensburg
- 1 Professional Contractor
- 1 City Official

There will be a possibility of 30 homes approved, as well as 5 full duty back up homes (in case a home owner decides not to participate), and 5 light duty homes, if approved home repairs are completed early on the first 30 homes.
